3. Alumni Feedback Analysis






The said feedback reports were discussed and analysed and consequently the following observation were made, decisions were taken and an action plan was proposed as follows:

- To enhance The Scope for enterpremerishp in the curriculum based on Institutional social Responsibility for Rural Development



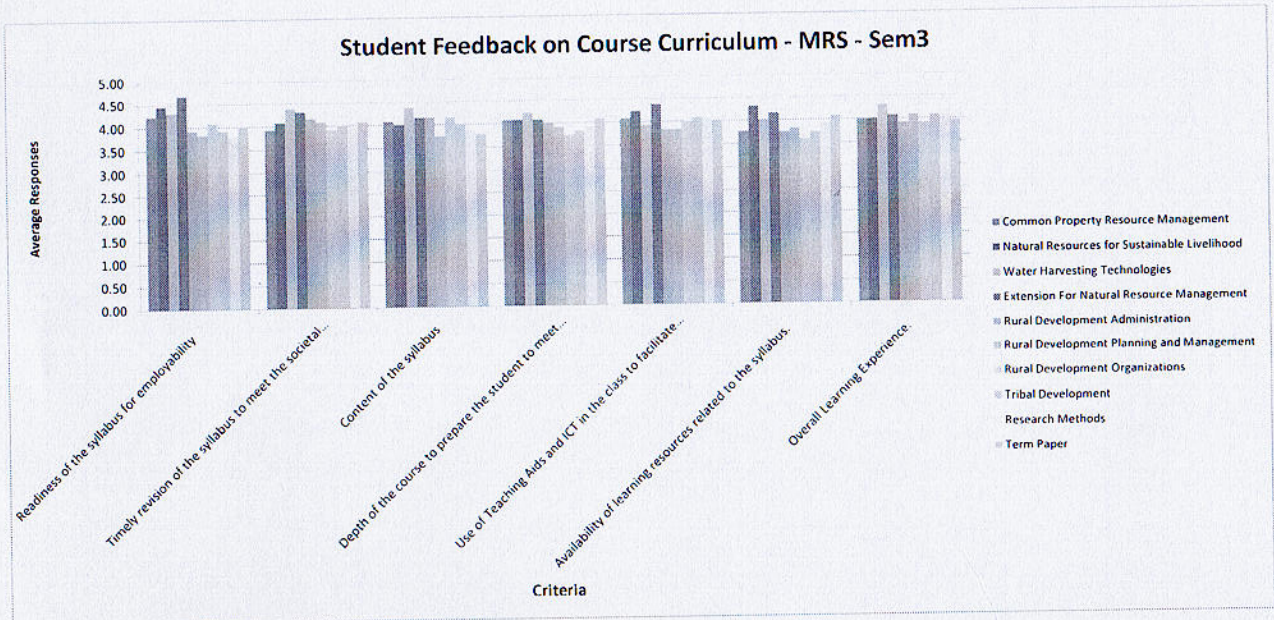
